Women's Substance Use Group Facilitator

The DEW (Daily Empowerment with Women) program is an evidence based, a non-residential program for women whose lives are being adversely affected by substance use. This program will provide structured individual and group treatment that fosters the well being of the whole person and their connectedness to self, family and community.

This part time program runs 4-5x per year averaging 21 hours/week days and evenings

Duties Include:

- Screen and interview clients for suitability for the program
- Facilitate outpatient treatment groups with women
- Assist women to develop healthy lifestyles, which do not include a reliance on substance use
- Enhance coping skills, self-esteem, and mental wellness
- Relapse prevention strategies and promote awareness of other resources throughout the community
- Maintain reports, records and statistics such as intake, progress and discharge
- Connect with other organizations including Interior Health, MCFD, in-patient treatment centres and substance use counsellors

Qualifications

- A post-secondary degree in counselling, psychology, social work, or human services
- Training in Substance Use and Addictions
- A minimum of 5 years' experience in facilitating groups
- Demonstrated practical experience delivering skill-based training to adult learners in a variety of settings
- Solid understanding of adult learning principles
- Superior communication, presentation and group facilitation skills
- Experience working with diverse cross section of clients
- Ability to adapt instructional materials and strategies to accommodate individual and group differences,
- In addition, facilitators should have expertise and/or practice in the following subjects:
Stages of Change/Stress Management/Resiliency/Grief and Loss/Boundaries/Empowerment
- Proficient with Microsoft Office including PowerPoint and other computer programs
- Ability to work independently
- Some evening work required
- Class 5 drivers licence and use of a vehicle
- Must pass a criminal record check and agency screening

Start date is March 9, 2020. Averaging 21 hours/ week (wage starting at \$27.00-29.00/hour based on experience plus company benefits). Position is dependent on continued funding.
